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



The IMU Postgraduate Diploma in Endodontics (PGDEndo) programme provides training in Endodontics for general dental practitioners. The curriculum is designed to enhance their knowledge and competencies in providing evidence-based Endodontic treatment of cases with different levels of difficulties. The programme aims to train the candidates to be competent in the understanding of pulpal and periapical pathophysiology, selection of appropriate dental materials/instruments, fundamental rationale of clinical techniques and managing failed Endodontic cases of moderate difficulty.
